



Introducing three new summer option classes

Drama

A two-week course aimed at improving students' confidence in conversational fluency through drama, including role-plays and improvisations. The first week focuses mainly on functional English in natural situations; while the second week covers areas such as intonation, articulation and pronunciation in creative and imaginary contexts.

Course details: Can be taken as part of any of our Option Courses. The drama option will run every two weeks from 04/07/2011 to 02/09/2011. Levels: Intermediate or above.

Fashion

A two-week course to increase students' knowledge of terminology used in fashion and their ability to talk fluently about fashion. In the first week, students write a fashion magazine. The second week is about creating a fashion show and reviewing it. At the end of the course each student receives a copy of the class fashion magazine and the opportunity to take a copy of the fashion show video.

Course details: Can be taken as part of any of our Option Courses. The fashion option will run on the following dates **only** - 11/07/11 to 22/07/11 and 08/07/11 to 19/08/11. Levels: Intermediate or above.

Music

A two-week course to build on students' interest in music whether they are interested in making it or just listening to it. The first week looks at music in general and how to play basic chords on a guitar, while the second week involves how to write and record a song. By the end of the course, the class will have recorded a song which they can take a copy of to take home.

Course details: Course details: Can be taken as part of any of our Option Courses. The fashion option will run on the following dates **only** - 25/07/11 to 05/08/11 and 22/08/11 to 19/08/11. Levels: Intermediate or above.

Please note: The options mentioned above are available as part of the following courses only - GE1-20, GE2-20, OP25, OP30 and OP 35. Our usual options of Conversation, Pronunciation and Business English will continue to run during this period. Students coming for longer than two weeks can change their options eg: two weeks of drama and one week of conversation or two weeks of fashion followed by two weeks of Business English. The three new options listed above should be booked in advance in order to avoid disappointment. All other options can be booked in advance or chosen on their first day at school.
